Book Review

"PRIMER OF FIGURE SKATING," by Maribel Y. Vinson, published by McGraw-Hill Book Company, Inc., 330 West 42nd St., New York 36, N. Y. 181 pages. Illustrated. \$2.45.

This book was first published in 1938 in slightly larger format with a hard cover. It was aimed at taking skaters from their first steps on ice through the USFSA Third Test. For many years, until it went out of print, it was one of the most popular books on the sport. Since then there have been many requests to have it re-issued, and at least McGraw-Hill has brought it out in a paperback edition. The book has been reset in clear legible type and the illustrations done in offset from the origi-

nals. After 25 years this is still one of the simplest and best textbooks on figure skating. No other book has better illustrations than these which were taken from movies of the author and clearly show how to execute the figures described. The chapter on dancing is somewhat out-of-date but gives clear directions on the four standard dances of that time (Waltz, Fourteenstep, Foxtrot, Tango) and these are still in use with only minor modifications. Maribel Vinson was an outstanding skater of figures and her knowledge, combined with her gift of vivid description, makes this a readable as well as a most valuable instruction book. Those who were not fortunate enough to purchase the original book will do well to buy and study this new paperback edition.— T.W.B.
